HOW TO GET INTO THE LIBRARY FROM HOME


Students can access the Oliver School Library from your phone, computer, internet access devices by following these steps.

Step 1.


Go to the NSW Department of Education web site



Some students' will have a number after their name. For example bill.jones1


Password should be 1057

Then click on Log In




