ELECTION BBQ AND CAKE STALL SATURDAY 2 DECEMBER

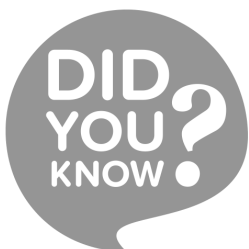
