PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Many of our students in Years 3-6 have participated in water safety lessons in the past week and a half. If the weather holds, these lessons will finish at the end of this week. I would like to recognise Mrs Kelly for her organisation to ensure that lessons went ahead. We are also thankful for the assistance of Armidale Secondary College students and staff in supporting our staff with our water safety program this year. I would expect that students enjoyed the opportunity to be in the water with the increased temperatures this week.

On Monday, our school met to listen to Year 5 students who were nominated for the role of school leader in 2021. I was very proud of each student as they gave their one-minute speech to appeal to students and staff for their votes. Students from Year 2 to Year 6, along with staff, voted for the four boys and four girls that they each thought would be the best student leaders next year.

Our Year 6 students will attend their farewell next Thursday night. Our thanks go to the organising committee for all of their preparation and ensuring that

this is a COVID-safe event. To meet requirements of the venue, the farewell will be for students and staff only. This year, graduation certificates will be given to students during the presentation day assembly. Mr Townsend is devising a way for our traditional Year 6 farewell tunnel to be held on the last day of the year while still allowing parents the opportunity to see their children going through a 'tunnel' and maintaining a distance from other adults.

Our P&C is organising the final meal deal of the year, a donut morning tea. All orders need to be received by the end of this week. No late orders will be accepted.

Presentation of awards

Due to the current restrictions, our school will not be following our usual Presentation Day program. On Friday, 11 December we will start the day by holding a brief whole school gathering to announce the school leaders for 2021. If the weather holds, this will be conducted outside with the parents of the new student councillors maintaining physical distancing so that they can be present as the names of our 2021 school captains are announced. If it is wet, these parents will not be able to attend any indoor announcement. Parents of these children will be informed shortly.

The first presentation of awards will be held with K-2 students and staff in the hall following the announcement of captains. The presentation of awards for students in Year 3-6 will take place after recess. We are unable to have parents attend as we would not be able to abide by the 4m2 requirement if we have visitors attend. Photographs of the presentations will be posted for those that have permission to be published. We are still determining whether we will be able to provide some form of closed online venue for hosting a video of the presentations as these cannot be publicly broadcast.

Orchestra concert

Our school orchestra and strings group will be performing two brief concerts for our students next Tuesday morning. Rather than a whole school concert, they will perform for half of the school at a time. These music students have been limited in their opportunities this year and are looking forward to performing, with some needing to change instruments to continue participating in orchestra.

End of year reminder

Student reports will be provided to students on Monday, 14 December 2020. Parents are reminded that children in Years 1-6 who are achieving at the expected level will be seen as 'sound' and awarded a C grade. Please take the time to read the explanation of grades on the front of each report. Kindergarten students will not receive a grade like older children. We ask that you consider the impact that COVID-19 has had on the learning of students this year when reading report comments.

With so many disruptions to learning brought about by COVID-19, it is important that students attend school on time every day until Wednesday, 16 December. Holidays commence on Thursday, 17 December. Students going into Years 1-6 will return to school on Friday, 29 January 2021. Kindergarten will start on Tuesday, 2 February 2021 after participating in Best Start assessments. More information to be provided to parents of enrolled Kinder students before the end of this year.


