Book Week 2022

"Dreaming with Eyes Open" Armidale City Public School will be celebrating the Children's' Book Council of Australia, Book Week 2022 from September 5 - 9 (Week 8). Students and teachers will be exploring some of Australia's finest books and step into their own Dreaming stories.



Some of the activities include:

Colouring Competition - students from years K-2 and 3-6 will each have the chance to win a jar of 'Milk and Cookies' - milk bottle lollies and fortune cookies. The competition opens Monday, 29 August and closes Friday, 2 September. Students may use pencils, textas, crayons and/or paint; one entry per student; the winners will be announced at morning lines on Monday, 5 September.

Book Character Parade - come dressed as a favourite character from any book on **Tuesday**, **6 September**. If children would like to come as a 'G' or 'PG' rated film/DVD/TV/movie character, they need to make sure that these were based on a book. Students may wear play clothes if they choose not to dress as a book character.
