

#### **Bus Passes**

All students who catch the following buses to/from school will need to show their bus pass to the driver from the beginning of Term 2:

#### S333; Uralla; East; Handel St; Perrott St; Taylor St and Markham St

Please ensure your child has one, and it is readily available for the bus driver to see. This may mean attaching it to your child's school bag. If your child does not have a bus pass, a \$1 fee (must be cash) will be charged (each way). Alternatively, it is possible to pay for a term bus pass (\$40 one way; \$80 both ways) by visiting the Edwards Buses office at 2 Drew Street.

Students who catch country buses do **NOT** require a bus pass **BUT MUST** be registered to travel on the bus. Please ensure your child is registered. If you are not registered, please use the following link to apply:

### **School Contributions and Reports**



#### **GENERAL SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS**

Under the Departments' Voluntary Contributions Policy 1995, we have sought agreement from the school community to ask parents and caregivers for a General School Contribution and a Technology Fee. Funds raised through the General School Contribution will be used to supplement government funding for educational resources and programs in our school. The Technology Fee will enable staff to meet the costs associated with providing the best possible Technology resources and opportunities for the students.

We appreciate your contribution as they will significantly enhance the resources made available to students.

School funds are supplemented by other school activities and funds raised by parent organisations for the benefit all of the students.

I have set out below the details of our General School Contribution and Technology Fee for this year and an outline of the manner in which funds may be expended.

It is anticipated that the funds raised will be expended on the following:

- \*General classroom equipment \*Photocopying—for student activities
- \*Teaching resources \*Library purchases—books, magazines etc
- \* Printing resources, computer resources, program support materials, subscriptions—site licences

The contribution for 2024 has been set at:

\$45.00 for one (1) student + \$10 technology fee

\$75.00 for two (2) students + \$20 technology fee

\$95.00 for three (3) or more students + \$30 technology fee
